Welcome to 2023!

A warm welcome to newcomers to Easts, and welcome back to our community of players, members, parents and supporters.

Luco and the team have been busy in the off-season, preparing for your return. You will notice a few changes, and a few improvements.

- The backfields are finally open. A wonderful green open space for training and playing. Come and watch Seniors Trial Game v UQ on Saturday week 11 March 2023.
- A new coffee outlet is opening in the old canteen space, for game days (watch this space, we are hoping to open 7 days a week).
- Food trucks are being trialled on a Friday night, with live music and a big screen to watch Super Rugby, so stick around.

We are proud of the programs we are offering this year, to help everyone enjoy the game we love, and do so in safety:

- Dedicated contact coaches for our Under 8 & 9 teams in 2023 to start the season
- Under 10 coaching seminars to provide guidance to teams playing their first seasons of full field rugby
- Dedicated scrum and safety sessions for all grades to assist with teaching of technical and safety aspects of the game
- Coach Education programs for all coaches and Referee Sessions to encourage our junior referees on 20 March.
- Junior training camps on the holidays for all levels.
- Medics one medic per field during home games, to ensure safe and speedy player care in the event of an injury or incident

Unfortunately we have had costs increases too, which has impacted our fees:

- field maintenance costs like water are having the biggest impact, estimated to cost as much \$60,000 this year over last year;
- operational costs are up more than 10% reflecting inflationary pressure in part and, in part, the cost of delivering these leading programs. This includes costs of medics, utilities, staffing and insurance.

As a result, the bad news is, fees for U8-16, Colts, and Seniors are up, on average 5%. The good news is, we have kept other fees down. Cubs, U7/8 and Girls fees are lower. And we are offering more generous family discounts than ever before, recognising the impact on families. Two other developments to mention:

- You will see David Wilson Field is out of action. This is part of significant upgrade to fix issues caused by the 2022 floods, funded by the State Government Community & Recreational Asset Recovery & Resilience Program. We expect works to complete in May this year and to play our home games back on the field for the balance of the season.
- 2. We will be opening the Master Development Plan to community consultation, and most importantly, your views and comments. This will be run as part of a Land Management Planning process in the first half of 2023.

At Despite these changes a few things remain the same. Easts, we value mateship over winning at all costs. We look after each other. We welcome diversity in all its forms. Easts is a great club, built on a proud 76 year history. We look forward to you joining us in 2023 to add the next chapter to our story.

JUNIOR RUGBY

Under 8 & Under 9 Confidence Tackle Zone Sessions

Our Under 8's are the first Junior age group to begin the transition into the tackling elements of rugby. At Easts we understand that this is a big change for our players and therefore think it is very important to provide them with the appropriate support and educations for safe tackling.

Easts will be running four Confidence Tackle Zone Sessions for our Under 8's and Under 9's this year.

-Session 1: 10th March

- Session 2: 17th March

- Refresh session: post Easter: 21st April

- Refresh session: post Term 2 school holidays: 14th July

These sessions will cover off on the following: - Pre tackle position footwork an setup -Safe tackling practise to be both effective tacklers and avoid injuries -Ball carrier focus on safe falling to ground methods to avoid injury and retain possession once tackled

All teams will rotate through 15min sessions on each of the above sessions. Advantage line coaches will run the sessions with the teams during these timeslots. Coaches from all teams will be sent the session content prior to the sessions taking place.
