Our Under 8's are the first Junior age group to begin the transition into the tackling elements of rugby. At Easts we understand that this is a big change for our players and therefore think it is very important to provide them with the appropriate support and educations for safe tackling.

Our teams have just completed their 2nd Confidence Tackle Zone session and will have two more refresh session post Easter, 21st April, and post Term 2 holidays, 14th July.

These sessions will cover off on the following:

- Pre tackle position footwork an setup
- -Safe tackling practise to be both effective tacklers and avoid injuries
- -Ball carrier focus on safe falling to ground methods to avoid injury and retain possession once tackled.
