Welcome GM

In this weeks edition of Tiger Tales we welcome the incoming Easts Tigers Rugby Union General Manager, Nigel Roy. Nigel commenced in the role on Monday 19th and is getting around to meet as many of the Tigers faithful. We thought that we would put the new GM on the spot with a few question and answers to help us familiarise ourselves with him.

1. What excites you most about joining Easts Rugby Union and taking on the General Managers role?

What people often don't realise is how Easts is such an important part of the local community, the welcome feeling that I received several years ago and is again reflected this time, is second to none. It is this sense of community and welcomeness that makes me excited for the role.

2. Can you share a bit about your professional background and how it aligns with the GM position?

My life (so far) has included many fantastic experiences, what is most applicable to my role is that I previously spent seven years as general manager for a Rugby Code in the Northern Territory. I was very grateful for the many magnificent volunteers that dedicate their time into making community and elite sport the best it can be. I look forward to meeting and getting to know everyone that contributes to the continued success at Easts.

3. You played for the mighty Easts Tigers in 2005 and 2006, what is your most memorable moment of the club?

My most memorable moment for the Easts Tigers is when I played my first senior game for the club. I came off the bench in second grade against Sunnybank and with my first touch of the ball for the club I managed to evade a defender to race away 40 yards and score adjacent to the uprights, this all occurred in front of my family. Coincidentally a photographer happened to capture images of that moment so we framed these photos. This set of photos is one of only two sets of photos that I have hanging at home so it must have been fate that I was to be back here at Tigerland many years later.

4. If you could give your younger self a piece of advice, what would it be?

I was very fortunate that I received some great advice and guidance in my younger days, but what resonated with me the most is that we can all be a bit more self-disciplined in our life. What I tell younger players is that this also includes doing things that you sometimes don't feel like doing, like doing that bit of exercise or going to bed earlier.

On behalf of everyone at Easts we extend a warm welcome to Nigel and eagerly anticipate the positive impact he will bring to Tigerland. We are excited about this new chapter and the fresh opportunities it presents for our organisation! #tigerforlife

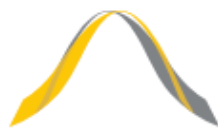

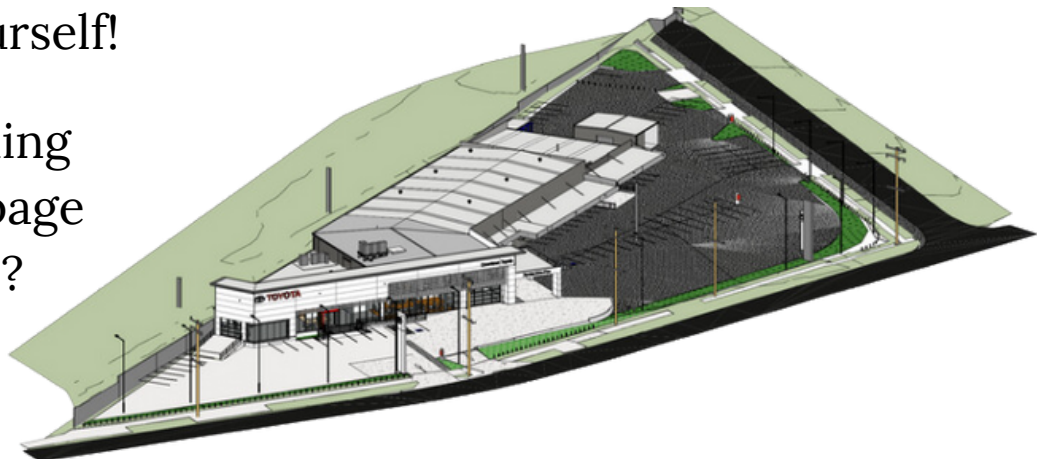
